GIRL CHILD EDUCATION AND PROTECTION

We work to ensure delivery of quality education through improvement of system and poor social cultural social norms that protects and lead girls to meet their dream.

SEXUAL REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND RIGHT (SRHR)

We work to support adolescents girls and young women exert their sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR), Which including their rights to make informed decisions about their bodies and have access to friendly sexual and reproductive health services such as access to correct inform, HIV&AIDS, family planning, maternal health. Through strengthening national health systems, improving social norms and advocating for policies supportive of services and rigth deliver



COMMUNITY HEALTH

We work to support community and health centers on the expansion of health care access for all and conduct research that informs both community, government and private sectors about disease, prevention measures and treatment in relation to community awareness and service delivered.

We provide training, leadership development and technical assistance to community and health center staff to support and strengthen health center operation.

WOMEN CAREER AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

We seek to advance the economic empowerment of women and girls by increasing women capacity, skills development, amplify their voice, increase visibility, increase promotion in different career and take part to lead in decision making to promote gender equality.

OUR PROJECT

PAMOJA PROJECT

The "Pamoja Project in Sumbawanga District Council is dedicated to end Gender Based Violence (GBV) specifically sexual Based violence targeting adolescent girls aged 15 to 17 who are in schools and out of schools. This initiative combines awareness-raising campaigns, comprehensive education on consent, gender equality, and respectful relationships. Through empowerment workshops and access to counseling services, the project aims to equip 500 young girls in 10 schools, 5 primary schools and 5 secondary school in sumbawanga district with the knowledge and confidence to speak out against violence and protect their rights. By collaborating with local schools, community leaders, and stakeholders, "Pamoja Project" seeks to create a safer environment for adolescent girls, where they can thrive and realize their full potential free from the fear of violence. Through this project we have been able to reach 1550 AGWY.

INAWEZEKANA PHASE 2

Inawezekana Phase 2 project in collaboration with government staff plan to conduct an activity of distributing reusable sanitary pad to 5 secondary schools at Sumbawanga District Council. The main goal is to increase awareness on menstrual health and right in schools and to reduce school dropout, absenteeism and increase performance at least 50% of girls students in 5 secondary schools by the end of November 2024 through increasing accessibility to affordable sanitary pads which safe are and sustainable. Though this project we have been able to reached 1150 where 1000 are in school girls, 100 out of school girls and 50 stakeholders

AGYW LEAD 2

This project is designed to reduce the rate of HIV/AIDS transmission among AGYW in Songwe Region. The goal of the project is to improve sexual and reproductive health outcomes of women and young girls aged 15 to 28 years living with HIV/AIDS including reducing their risk of unintended pregnancy in Songwe Region (Momba District and Songwe council) by 2% from 6.0% by 2026. The project aims to achieve this goal by providing education and information on safe sex practices, access to contraception and family planning services, Strengthening HIV treatment, care and service delivery in Health centres to increase drug adherence and addressing stigma and discrimination related to HIV and reproductive health.

OUR PROJECT

YOUNG HERO (SHUJAA MDOGO)

This project aims to tackle teen marriages and pregnancies by challenging social cultural norms and practices limiting girls access to education. Through targeted interventions, it seeks to increase girls' access to education, with a focus on changing cultural attitudes. The project leverages data to understand the specific factors contributing to teen marriages and pregnancies. By analyzing cultural norms, its tailors' interventions to challenge harmful practices. This initiative strives to create a supportive environment for girls, emphasizing education as a key tool for empowerment.

HER CAREER FORUM

This annual program for both in and out of school girls designed for helping young girls to explore areas of interest and giving them opportunities to see what a real career looks like. Her career forum support sustainability in number of ways and encourage young girls to get interest in different career aspects nurture and support their goal to reach their future through mentorship.

CHUNGU MASTERING PROGRAM

Chungu is a monthly basis platform which unite girls in their community to discuss different issues on women and girls development, including career, leadership, business, branding, and skills development, where they get an opportunity to meet with mentors in different career aspects.
